SUBJECT: GUIDELINES FOR PEACEFUL ELECTION CAMPAIGNS

We have received reports of violence emanating from student election campaigns' incidences with some students injured. Additionally, as of February 5, 2025, five students are in police custody due to campaign-related violence, including incidents in off-campus areas.

As election campaigns begin, we urge all students to conduct them peacefully and responsibly. We strongly advise all students to avoid any form of violence. Candidates and their teams must ensure supporters adhere to KAFUSA election rules and national laws.

To prevent disruptions, vuvuzela use and chanting are restricted to 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM. Furthermore, campaigning is prohibited in the Administration Block, Assembly Hall, and Governors Hall areas. The university has enhanced security to maintain order and ensure student safety.

Let us all work together to uphold a peaceful election period.
